

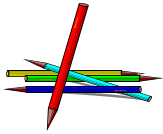

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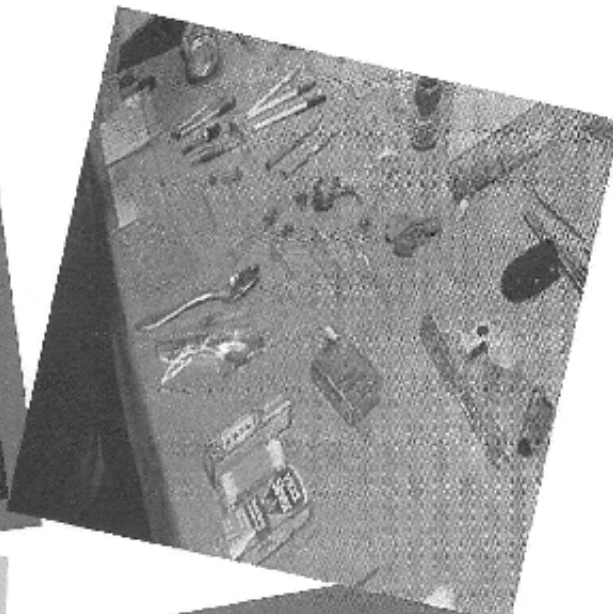

## "SCRIP NEWS"

Happy New Year! We had a VERY successful Christmas Season! Thanks to all who purchased Gift Cards and Gift certificates? You helped lower your tuition and helped the school. THANKS!

If you would like to track your Cash and Carry purchases from the Office, please feel free to ask our lovely and always helpful Secretaries to make a copy of your order sheet. Simply grab an old folder and keep your copies (along with online order sheets and dispersal sheets) in it. When you receive your dispersal you can check it against your records. If there are any discrepancies, the SCRIP team has a reference point to start from.

Also, please note the percentages of the cards you purchased. Some cards have very high percentages, while others are lower. While EVERY purchase helps lower your tuition, please understand what your card purchase is earning. Also, some quarters we have 100% earnings, others 50%. So if a card earns 10%, during 50% earning periods you will get 5% and the school will get 5%. Please take these factors into consideration when looking over your dispersal totals.

The last dispersal for 2011 is completed and in the process of being sent out. We appreciate your patience with this matter. Your SCRIP team consists of volunteers who work very hard to help our families and our school. Thank you for understanding. Jodi Wisneski, SCRIP Coordinator
